The Cascade Australian Cattle Dog Club, Inc. assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information provided by the owner or the owner's agent on the entry form. **ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED, CANCELLED, ALTERED OR SUBSTITUTED AFTER ENTRIES HAVE CLOSED.**

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge or barred from participation by the Trial Committee. If it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Entries will not be accepted without entry fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$40.00 fee to the amount of each returned check. Returned checks from an exhibitor will result in their being on a cash basis only.

Buckeye All Breed Herding Club, and Chris Kleman and Brian Kleman assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their dogs on leash (except when in the arena or stock dogs when working) and under control at all times. Exhibitors **MUST** clean up after their dogs. We would like to be able to use this facility for future test/trials.

Refunds/Alternates

If you pull your entry (ies) prior to closing your check will be either returned or a full refund made.

If your dog is pulled after entries close and an alternate fills your place, a full refund will be made.

If your dog is pulled after entries close without an alternate taking your place, no refund will be made. In the event of a spouse, sibling, parent or entered dog's passing; a board decision will be made.

If you are an alternate and pull prior to closing your check will be returned.

If you are an alternate and do not have an opportunity to run, you will receive a full refund.

If you are an alternate, have the opportunity to run and are not present to run your dog, no refund will be made.

AGREEMENT

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. The entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and Agreement. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. And I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. I (we) will pay for any injuries or the replacement value in this event or serious injury to the livestock caused by my (our) dog. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.
