This trial is not sanctioned by any association. It is a fun match and fundraiser for BAHA, open to all herding breeds. Available stock will be ducks (A) and sheep (A) – all classes are accepted: Advanced, Intermediate, Started, and Beginner. Trial sheep will be used for all classes but Beginner, which will be run with test sheep in a smaller area than the trial field.

Entries open March 15, 2025. Day of trial entries will be accepted, if trial has not filled prior to trial day.

There will be 36 sheep runs available and 36 duck runs. The cost per team is \$30 **per stock** for BAHA members, and \$40 **per stock** for non-members – which will give you 2 runs per entry.

BAHA POINTS AND TIME TRIAL RULES

General Rules

1. Highest points with the lowest time win the class.
2. One head of stock must go through the obstacle to get 1 point for that obstacle. Handlers may move on without any stock going through the obstacle, but no points will be earned for that obstacle. Handlers may continue to try and get one head of stock through the obstacle until time runs out.
3. One point for each head of stock that completes an obstacle is awarded.
4. Time starts when the handler sends the dog.
5. Time stops when the gate is closed after the re-pen.
6. Ties will be broken by the lowest time at least one head of stock completes obstacle 1. If that doesn't break the tie, a runoff with a shortened course will determine the winner.
7. There is no judging, only a score keeper to keep track of points and a time keeper.
8. Stock will be let into the arena and not held.
9. If stock enter or exit an obstacle the wrong way, the stock must exit the obstacle and enter and exit in the correct direction to earn points.
10. Dogs will be excused for chasing and unnecessary gripping. Points will be awarded up to the excusal.
11. Course maps will be available at the trial but not before.
12. Obstacles will be numbered and must be attempted in numerical order. No retries on obstacles after moving on.
13. Three heads of sheep and five ducks will be used.

Beginner Class (100 x 200 ft. arena)

1. Dogs with test titles and herding started legs but no trial titles may enter this class.
2. Test sheep will be used.
3. 8 minutes max time allowed.
4. Handlers may go anywhere on the field, including inside obstacles. Handler and dog may get as close to the stock as they want to start.
5. Dogs in this class may only enter on sheep.

Started Class (159 x 247 ft. sheep arena)

1. Dogs with a herding started title and/or herding intermediate legs but no intermediate title may enter this class.
2. Trial sheep will be used.
3. 8 minutes max time allowed.
4. Handlers may go anywhere on the field, except inside the obstacles.
5. Handlers may enter sheep and ducks.

Intermediate Class (159 x 247 ft. sheep arena)

1. Dogs with a herding intermediate title and advanced legs but no advanced title may enter this class.
2. 8 minutes max time allowed.
3. Handlers will be restricted to a handler line except for free standing obstacles.
4. Handlers may enter sheep and ducks.

Advanced Class (159 x 247 ft sheep arena)

1. Dogs with an advanced title on any stock and/or an HC must enter this class.
2. 8 minutes max time allowed.
3. Handlers will be restricted to the handler's post except for free standing obstacles. Handler and dog start at the handler's cone.
4. Handlers may enter sheep and ducks.

Payouts

1. 1st place in each class gets 15% of entries in that class
2. 2nd place in each class gets 10% of entries in that class
3. 3rd place in each class gets 5% of entries in that class
4. Rosehaeven Farm gets 35% of total entries
5. BAHA gets 35% of total entries
